Fourteen volunteers hand-pulled hounds tongue and knapweed from the Lower Woodchuck drainage along the southern boundary of MPG Ranch.



Volunteers piled the weeds on the concrete slab
where the road crosses Woodchuck Creek.





The map above shows where volunteers pulled houndstongue and knapweed on 10/13/12. Volunteers began at MPG's western property line in the Lower Woodchuck drainage and worked their way east to where the drainage forks. Then they worked up the north and south forks to within 100 yards of the barbed wire fence that crosses the drainage.
